Senior Deputy District Attorney John MacKinnon has been with the Santa Barbara County District Attorney's Office since 2000. Prior to that, DDA MacKinnon worked at the Fresno County District Attorney's Office. John MacKinnon grew up on the Central Coast. He was born and raised in Santa Maria. He has handled nearly all types of criminal prosecutions during his career which includes over two years at the Juvenile Court in Santa Maria.

DDA MacKinnon will be discussing Welfare and Institutions § 786 which require action from the court, district attorney's office and law enforcement offices. All agencies are required to affirmatively seal and destroy juvenile records when the juvenile has successfully completed his/her probation.
