Topic: CARPOS (California Restraining and Protective Order System)

Vivian Garcia has worked for the Department of Justice for 31 years. Vivian has served in numerous secretarial and analytical positions in several Divisions/Bureaus including the Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement, Bureau of Forensic Services, Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information, CJIS Executive Office, and the Client Services Program. In October of 2004 she accepted a position as a Field Representative for the ACHS CORI Audit section and in January of 2009, Ms. Garcia was assigned to the CARPOS Unit. She is responsible for auditing and training law enforcement agencies and the entering courts of California. In 2011 Ms. Garcia was assigned to the Law Enforcement Support Program's CARPOS Unit and thoroughly enjoys working with co-worker Tom Stoner, Manager Lydia Pantoja, her agencies and courts, and all LESP staff.

Training will focus on the forms that were revised as of January 1, 2017. This will include gun violence restraining order types, and the addition of cell phone information and inclusion of pets on all forms. Training packets will include all orders, mandated for entry, but due to time constraints, will only cover new and key update information.

CARPOS is the central repository of active and historical restraining and protective orders. Information maintained in CARPOS is used by law enforcement to identify persons named in restraining and protective orders and includes specified data on the terms and conditions of these orders. Accuracy and timely entry of records is of utmost importance to assist in the protection of citizens and peace officers of California.
